The Process

1. Go to EmpowerIllinois.org beginning Tuesday, February 27 at 7:00 P.M. to start your application.
2. Complete the form with your name and contact information to timestamp your application.
3. Note: This step will determine your place in line for the first-come, first-served scholarships
4. Also submit your home address, the names of your children, their dates of birth, and your preferred school.
5. Note: Only one reservation and application are allowed per family – even if you are applying for several students.
6. Take note of your confirmation code after completing your reservation.
7. Wait to receive an email link to your unique application where you will complete it and upload all required documents. Emails will be sent on a rolling basis and may take several weeks.
8. You will have 3 days to complete your application once your link has been sent. Complete it at a time convenient for you and be sure all documents are provided.

El proceso

1. Ir a EmpowerIllinois.org a partir del martes 27 de febrero a 19:00 para iniciar la aplicación.
2. Complete el formulario con su nombre y su información de contacto para marcar la fecha y la hora de su aplicación.
3. *Nota: Este paso determinará su lugar en la fila para las becas por orden de llegada.*
4. También ingrese su domicilio, los nombres de sus hijos, sus fechas de nacimiento y su escuela de preferencia.
5. *Nota: Solo se permiten una reserva y una aplicación por familia, incluso si aplica por becas para varios estudiantes.*
6. Tome nota de su código de confirmación después de completar su reserva.
7. Esperar para recibir un enlace de correo electrónico para su aplicación única en la que la perfeccionará y cargar todos los documentos requeridos. Los correos electrónicos se enviarán de forma continua y pueden demorar varias semanas.
8. Tendrá 3 días para completar su aplicación una vez que se haya enviado su enlace. Complete la aplicación en un momento que le resulte conveniente y asegúrese de proporcionar todos los documentos.

10:00am-they will take the first 50 people (recommended to arrive early and bring bags)

EVERY 4TH THURSDAY OF THE MONTH.
(Except this month which was on 2/15)
4:00pm- (recommended to arrive early and bring bags)
This is open to ALL Chicago Residents, no I.D. is necessary.
